

## Overall: BETTER JUSTICE...for the 21st C

ACCESS: eJustice...start to bring legal procedures and practices into electronic age; create an online system for simplest magistrate cases	Engage with young lawyers and web designers to devise methodology
ACCESS: Costs/delay: use online & review for simple cases, plus McKenzie friends, "consultant" lawyers, for next rank of cases	Springboard off the online system for lawyer-level-according-to-need
QUALITY: Create formal learning system for judges, magistrates; introduce a reporting/accountability system for their decisions	Stringent review system akin to that of aviation crashes or medical mistakes
QUALITY: Develop a system to measure the output/impact of magistrates and judges, and DPPs (qualitative and quantitative)	Partner with a 'measurement' agency and uni to develop methodology (ies)
IMPROVE: 100-year review of basic laws, eg Crimes Act, for improved consistency across all Oz jurisdictions (incl. bail, sentencing, parole, etc)	Achieve 1/100-year reform, plus alignment of bail, sentencing, etc
IMPROVE: Freedoms review by ALRC, plus trafficked persons/slavery, juvenile Aboriginal justice: BoR campaign in Queensland	Translate aspirations into day-to-day reality for citizens, more bills of rights
INNOVATE: Right To Appeal law in all jurisdictions; campaign for national or state/territory criminal cases review system, or similar	Create national or state/territory system to review judgements externally
INNOVATE: Create rolling Royal Commission into police services; address poss. similar problem among federal security/crime agencies	Avoid endemic problems by regular external reviews, on rotation
IMPLEMENT: OPCAT implementation, then annual inspection of prisons by independent outsiders; improve education in all prisons/states	Achieve legislation in all states and territories; develop e-prison programs
IMPLEMENT: System of 'blue' papers for any new police/spook law for consideration by federal or state/territory parliaments (like 'white' papers)	With federal MPs & Senators to create more robust analysis system. 151231
